3. **Public affairs:** PAO Mrs. Joyce Williams has submitted monthly notices of PVC meetings and follow up reports and pictures of participants to the local newspaper, the Farmville Herald. The resultant publicity has been well received.
4. **Chapter vitality and levels of excellence:**
