Legislative Affairs: President, COL Victoria Revilla and Legislative Representatives, COL Gary Metzinger/COL Albert Pianalto, participated in the VCOC Congressional Luncheon; we hosted Congressman Randy Forbes and members of his staff. COL Pianalto and COL Bill Flanagan were among the VCOC representatives at a recent office call with Congressman Forbes in order to discuss the 2011 legislative objectives. COL Metzinger and COL Pianalto participated in the June 2010 VCOC Legislative Committee planning.

3. Public Affairs: Scholarship Committee members attended awards ceremonies in 7 different high schools to present 10 Roper Memorial Scholarships worth \$1000 each. Two of the scholarship presentations were covered in local community newspapers and one was on the school website. COL Revilla and the ROTC Coordinator, MAJ Kirk Jones, presented 5 MOAA to local JROTC cadets at their awards ceremonies; one was presented at the VA State University ROTC ceremony. COL Bill Flanagan provided press release and photo that appeared on the Richmond-Times Dispatch reporting the VCOC visit with Congressman Randy Forbes.
