2. Legislative Affairs: Four Chapter Members: COL Victoria Revilla, Col Gary Metzinger, Col Al Pianalto and LCDR Alvin Peschke attended the Congressional Luncheon on 24 June. Legislative Representatives, Metzinger and Pianalto, have attended the VCOC Legislative meetings and submitted the chapter's recommendations. A chapter thank-you letter was sent to Congressman Randy Forbes.

3. Public Affairs:

. A press release and picture of the ROTC Award and Southside Scholarship recipients was published by the Richmond Times Dispatch and the Surrey-Sussex County Community News. A second press release with picture on the Congressional luncheon was also submitted, but not published.

. Chapter representatives have presented scholarship and ROTC awards at 10 separate high schools during the months of May and July. COL Revilla presented Gold Bar Certificates and free memberships to 17 new Army lieutenants at the Virginia State University commissioning ceremony; photos were published in the VSU website.

. COL Revilla, was the guest speaker at the Edgewood School District's Memorial Day Celebration in San Antonio, Texas, with over 500 people in attendance. Publicity on the event was handled locally.

. The chapter's Memorial Society members attended to placing U.S. flags on veterans' graves at the local veterans cemetery, Southlawn Memorial Park.

4. Chapter Vitality & Levels of Excellence: Award form submitted, expect score of 230 and 5-star level award.

5. Most Significant Chapter Event of the Quarter: A Southside Awards Ceremony was held on 4 June at the Virginia War Memorial. Eleven (11) students received a \$1000 scholarship (total of \$11K) and four ROTC cadets received the MOAA Medal. Students, their parents, instructors and chapter members attended the reception and later toured the memorial.
