2. **Legislative affairs:** Legislative Rep COL Duane Benton hand delivered a copy of the MOAA National Legislative priorities to Congressman Perriello of the 5th District of Virginia. He thanked the Chapter and will support the priorities during military deliberations of the 111<sup>th</sup> Congress. COL Benton prepared and distributed a “ Political Points of Contact List” for use by Chapter members for the recent Virginia General Assembly and for President Obama, Senators Warner, Webb and Congressman Perriello.
  
3. **Public affairs:** PAO CAPT and Mrs. Joe Williams have contributed a monthly Chapter function photo and narrative published in the local newspaper, The Farmville Herald. Chapter news also appears on the Chapter web page. VAVET was briefed by CAPT Joe Williams at the March 19 Chapter meeting. At the same meeting, a feedback report on the 11 March Legislative Meeting was given by PAO Mrs. Joe Williams. LCOL Rucker Snead USA (ret) of Hampden-Sydney College reported that HSC plans a 65<sup>th</sup> WWII Anniversary Symposium April 15-17 in Farmville. Topics will be: The Place of WWII in History, Merrill’s Marauders, The Holocaust and the Broad Impact of War.
  
4. **Chapter vitality and levels of excellence:**
  - a. Self evaluation score for the Quarter: Score: 43 Improvement needed. While the Chapter is functioning at a satisfactory level, it appears that a better “paper trail” is required to meet the suggested improvement levels.
  
  - b. Levels of excellence Status: Score: 180. No descriptive term available. Same general comments for improvement apply as noted above.
  
5. **Most significant Chapter event of the quarter:** The Chapter contributed \$250 to the Virginia War Memorial for the commemorative bricks. The Chapter was also the first MOAA group to donate \$200 for the Haiti earthquake relief.
